

How do I receive/turn off email notifications from this forum?

You can control the email notifications from this forum by clicking on the edit profile link at the top of the page ...



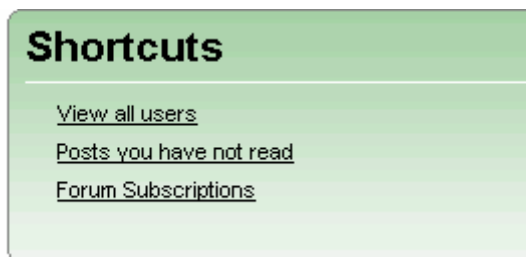
Then selecting the Email tab in the edit profile window ...



The email tab allows you to configure notification and contact by email options, along with the options for you to enter other communication methods you may wish to be contacted by. If there are no available options in the "Email Options" section then the administrator has disabled the email subsystem of the community.

- **Receive Emails:** "Yes" enables emails to be sent to you from the community. These will be sent to the email address you provided during registration which you can change in the "Private Email" option. Select "No" if you do not want to receive emails. Note that the sender of an email to you will not be able to see your email address, however if you reply via your email client they will know email address. This is beyond the control of this community
- **Receive rich (HTML) emails:** Set to "Yes" if you would like to receive emails in html (where applicable) format. No will cause emails to be sent in plain text format
- **Enable Email Notifications:** Setting this option to "Yes" allows you to be notified by email of new posts to forums/threads you have subscribed to. You will also be notified by email of any replies to one of your posts.

You can also subscribe to specific forums by clicking the Forum Subscription link in the shortcuts box ...



And then selecting the forums that you wish to receive emails from ...

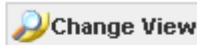
